RESOLUTION PLACING A SIX MONTH MORATORIUM ON TEMPORARY HOUSING.

**WHEREAS**, The City of Williston, believes that it is not in the City's best interest to continue to allow temporary housing within the City limits or within the City's one-mile jurisdiction; and

**WHEREAS**, the city of Williston will review this issue in a reasonable manner if the need arises;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of City Commissioners of the City of Williston, North Dakota, as follows:

No temporary housing within the City of Williston or within the City's one-mile jurisdiction, shall be allowed for a period of six months from the date of the signing of this document.

This resolution does not apply to developments which have already been approved, but all developments will be subject to annual review.

Commissioner Cymbaluk, moved the adoption of the foregoing Resolution. The Motion was seconded by Commissioner Klug, On roll call vote of the Commissioners vote AYE": Klug, Cymbaluk, Bogar, Bekkedahl, & Koeser and the following Commissioners voted "NAY": None. Absent and not voting: None.
