

Ordinance No. 996 – Lawn Watering

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WILLISTON AMENDING CHAPTER 22, SECTION 22-63, PARAGRAPH (2) OF THE WILLISTON CODE OF ORDINANCES REGARDING WATER EMERGENCY AS SET OUT BELOW.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF WILLISTON, NORTH DAKOTA:

**Section 22-63. Restrictions and prohibited uses.**

(2) In order to minimize peak demands on the City's water treatment and distribution system, the use of municipal water for the purposes of sprinkling or irrigating yards, lawns, gardens, trees, shrubbery, grass or any other vegetation shall be done in accordance with the following schedule:

- a. Persons living in dwelling structures which have a street address number assigned ending in an even digit may use water outside such structure only on Mondays, Wednesdays, Fridays, and Sundays.
- b. Persons living in dwelling structures which have a street address number assigned ending in an odd digit may use water outside such structure only on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Saturdays.

For the purposes of this ordinance, any street address number ending in a fraction shall be deemed to be an odd number.

Commissioner Cymbaluk moved the adoption of the foregoing Ordinance. The motion was Seconded by Commissioner Brostuen. On roll call vote of the Commissioners, the following Commissioners voted "AYE": Cymbaluk, Brostuen, Bekkedahl and Klug; and the following Commissioners voted "NAY": none. Absent and not voting: none.

WHEREUPON, the motion was passed and the Ordinance declared adopted this 24<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2014.
