**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 31 OF ORDINANCE 613, ALSO KNOWN AS THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WILLISTON, IN REGARDS TO THE DEFINITION OF DWELLING, TWO FAMILY**

Be it ordained by the Board of City Commissioners of the City of Williston, North Dakota:

The Section 31 of Ordinance 613 also known as the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Williston is hereby amended to read:

**Sec. 31. Definitions**

**Dwelling, Two-Family**

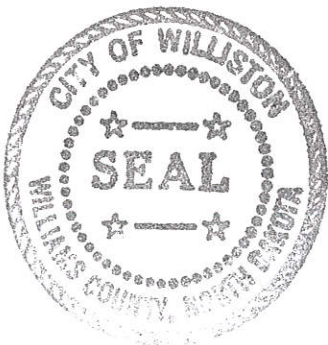
~~A structure on a single lot containing two dwelling units that meets the following requirements:~~ A one-family dwelling attached to one other one-family dwelling by a common vertical wall, with each dwelling located on a separate lot. This also includes a building containing two single-family dwelling units located on the same lot. A two-family dwelling must comply with the following requirements:
