

CITY OF WILLISTON ORDINANCE NO. 904

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 875 AMENDING SECTION 10-63 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF WILLISTON, ADOPTING FEES REQUIRED FOR VIOLATION OF THE SPEED LIMITS IN THE CITY OF WILLISTON, NORTH DAKOTA

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF WILLISTON, NORTH DAKOTA,

Section 10-63 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Williston, North Dakota, is hereby amended and reenacted as follows:

Section 10-63. Same – Amount of Fee.

The fees required for a non-criminal disposition pursuant to either Section 10-60 or Section 10-51 – 10-58 shall be as follows:

1. For a non-moving violation as defined in Section 10-62, a fee in the amount of twenty dollars (\$20.00).
2. For a moving violation as defined in Section 10-61, a fee in the amount of thirty dollars (\$30.00).
3. For a violation of Section 10-154, the penalty shall be a fee as follows:

Speed (mph over speed limit)	Fee
1-5	\$5
6-10	\$5 plus \$1/each mph over 5 mph over limit
11-15	\$10 plus \$1/each mph over 10 mph over limit
16-20	\$15 plus \$2/each mph over 15 mph over limit
21-25	\$25 plus \$3/each mph over 20 mph over limit
26-35	\$40 plus \$3/each mph over 25 mph over limit
36-45	\$70 plus \$3/each mph over 35 mph over limit
46 plus	\$100 plus \$5/each mph over 45 mph over limit


4. For a violation of Section 10-150 defining careless driving, a fee in the amount of thirty dollars (\$30.00).
5. For a violation of Section 10-7 defining care required in driving, a fee of not less than ten dollars (\$10.00) nor more than thirty dollars (\$30.00).

Commissioner Bekkedahl moved the adoption of the foregoing Ordinance. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Bogar. Upon roll call vote, the following Commissioners voted "AYE": Bogar, Bekkedahl and Lawson, and the following Commissioners voted "NAY": None. Absent and not voting: Underhill and Koeser.

WHEREUPON, the motion was passed and the Ordinance declared amended this 10th day of June, 2008.
