


AN ORDINANCE MAKING IT ILLEGAL TO SELL CITY WATER FOR COMMERCIAL PURPOSES WITHOUT THE CONSENT OF THE WILLISTON CITY COMMISSION

Section 22 of the Williston Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to add the following:

- a. No person shall, without the consent of the Williston City Commission, sell City water for commercial purposes.
- b. Any person violating this section shall be subject to a fine as stated in Section 1-11 of this code.

**CITY OF WILLISTON ORDINANCE NO. 927**

AN ORDINANCE MAKING IT ILLEGAL TO SELL CITY WATER FOR COMMERCIAL PURPOSES WITHOUT THE CONSENT OF THE WILLISTON CITY COMMISSION.

Penalty: Whenever in this Code or in any ordinance of the city any act is prohibited or is made or declared to be unlawful or an offense, or whenever in this Code or any ordinance the doing of any act is required or the failure to do any act is declared to be unlawful, where no specific penalty is provided therefor, any person upon conviction for the violation of any such provision of this Code or any ordinance shall be punished by a fine not exceeding one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or by imprisonment not to exceed thirty (30) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment, for each such offense. Each day any violation of any provision of this Code or of any ordinance shall continue shall constitute a separate offense. In the construction and interpretation of this section, the revocation of a license or permit shall not be considered as a recovery or penalty so as to bar any other penalty from being enforced.
