

**RESOLUTION NO. 13-034**

Commissioner Bogar introduced the following Resolution and moved its adoption:

**RESOLUTION CREATING WATER AND SEWER IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 13-7 OF THE CITY OF WILLISTON, NORTH DAKOTA.**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF WILLISTON, NORTH DAKOTA:

1. There are hereby created and added to an Improvement District in the City of Williston, designated and known as **WATER AND SEWER IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 13-7** for the purpose constructing the following:

A Water and Sewer Line along East Dakota Parkway to the Schroeder, Carnes, Barstad and the Williston Park District properties.

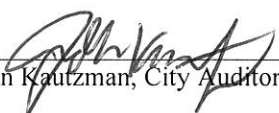
2. That said Section being added to **WATER AND SEWER IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 13-7** shall contain and involve the following described real property situated in the City of Williston, Williams County, North Dakota, described as follows:

Commencing at the southwest corner of Lot 1, Block 1 of the Tofte Bean Subdivision, thence N02°21'20"E a distance of 177.77 feet to the Point of Beginning; thence S88°00'18"E along the north line of said Lot 1 a distance of 147.62 feet; thence N02°28'23"E along the east line of said Lot 1 a distance of 147.76 feet; thence S87°58'49"E along the north line of the Tofte Bean Subdivision a distance of 84.5 feet; thence N02°50'40"E a distance of 236.91 feet to the Corps of Engineer's Boundary Line; thence N59°04'30"W along the Corps of Engineer's Boundary Line a distance of 394.4 feet; thence N02°12'04"E a distance of 70.74 feet; thence N87°47'59"W a distance of 455.05 feet to the east Right of Way line of East Dakota Parkway; thence south easterly along said east Right of Way line of East Dakota Parkway to the southwest corner of Plot 18 of Homecroft 2nd Addition; thence S87°47'56"E along the south line of Plot 18 of Homecroft 2nd Addition a distance of 14.08 feet; thence S35°01'56"E a distance of 181.55 feet to the Point of Beginning. Said Description contains 0.06 Acres or 2701.76 Square Feet more or less.
