**RESOLUTION DIRECTING ENGINEER FOR THE CITY OF WILLISTON TO PREPARE A REPORT AS TO THE GENERAL NATURE, PURPOSE, AND FEASIBILITY OF THE PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT AND AN ESTIMATE AS TO THE PROBABLE COST OF WORK FOR ALLEY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 13-9.**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF WILLISTON, NORTH DAKOTA:


That the City Engineer for the City of Williston, North Dakota, prepare a report as the general nature, purpose, and feasibility of the proposed improvement and an estimate of the probable cost of the work for **ALLEY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 13-9**, which is an improvement project consisting of the following:

Section I—Alley Improvements—Block 5 of the Heffernan Rearrangement and Block 1 of the Missouri Rearrangement.  
Alley paving in Block 5 of the Heffernan Rearrangement and Block 1 of the Missouri Rearrangement.

Section II—Alley Improvements—Block 1 of the Thomas Subdivision.  
The regrading and graveling of the existing gravel alley located in the south half of Block 1 of the Thomas Subdivision.

The motion for the adoption of the foregoing Resolution was duly seconded by Commissioner Cymbaluk, and upon vote being taken thereon, the following Commissioners voted "AYE": Bekkedahl, Klug, Cymbaluk, Bogar and Koeser; and the following voted "NAY": None.
