

RESOLUTION NO. 13-044

Commissioner Bogar introduced the following Resolution and moved its adoption:

RESOLUTION DECLARING NECESSITY OF AN IMPROVEMENT IN ALLEY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 13-9.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF WILLISTON, NORTH DAKOTA:

That the Board of City Commissioners has received the Engineer's Report for the **ALLEY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 13-9**, and determines that it is necessary to make the following improvements:

Section I—Alley Improvements—Block 5 of the Heffernan Rearrangement and Block 1 of the Missouri Rearrangement.
Alley paving in Block 5 of the Heffernan Rearrangement and Block 1 of the Missouri Rearrangement.

Section II—Alley Improvements—Block 1 of the Thomas Subdivision.
The regrading and graveling of the existing gravel alley located in the south half of Block 1 of the Thomas Subdivision.

That the boundaries of said improvement District are as follows:

Section I—Alley Improvements —Missouri Rearrangement.
Lot 8 through 15, Block 5 of the Heffernan Rearrangement and Lot 16 through 25, Block 1 of the Missouri Rearrangement.

Section II—Alley Improvements—Block 1 of the Thomas Subdivision.
Lots 7 through 18 of Block 1 of the Thomas Subdivision.


As shown on the attached maps.

That this Resolution Declaring the Necessity to make the improvements described in the Engineer's Reports previously filed here in for Section I and Section II shall not require a protest hearing because of the written petitions received by the Board of City Commissioners as allowed by the provisions of Section 40-22-15 of the North Dakota Century Code.

That the City Auditor is hereby authorized and directed to cause the Resolution Declaring Necessity of an improvement in **ALLEY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 13-9** to be published once each week for two (2) consecutive weeks in the official newspaper of the city.

The motion for the adoption of the foregoing Resolution was duly seconded by Commissioner Cymbaluk, and upon vote being taken thereon, the following Commissioners voted "AYE": Bekkedahl, Klug, Cymbaluk, Bogar and Koeser; and the following voted "NAY": None. Absent and not voting: None. Whereupon said motion was declared duly passed and adopted this **26th day of March, 2013**.
