

RESOLUTION NO. 13-077

Commissioner Cymbaluk introduced the following Resolution and moved its adoption:

RESOLUTION DECLARING NECESSITY OF AN IMPROVEMENT IN WATER AND SEWER IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 13-11.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF WILLISTON, NORTH DAKOTA:

That the Board of City Commissioners has received the Engineer's Report for the **Water and Sewer Improvement District 13-11** and determines that it is necessary to make the following improvements:

Constructing a water and sewer system along Town & Country Lane from US Highway 2 & 85 to Sunset Boulevard and along both Sunrise Drive and Sunset Boulevard going west from Town and Country Lane.

That the boundaries of said improvement District are as follows:

A Tract of land lying in Section 20 of Township 154 North, Range 101 West of the 5th Principal Meridian, City of Williston, Williams County, North Dakota, said tract being more particularly described as follows:

Lots 1 and 2 of Block 1 and Lots 1 and 2 of Block 2 of the Whitlock Industrial Park Subdivision; Lots 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 of Block 2, Lots 1 and 2 of Block 3 and Lots 1R and 2 of Block 4 of the Sunset Subdivision.


As shown on the attached map.

That the City Auditor is hereby authorized and directed to cause the Resolution Declaring Necessity of an improvement in **Water and Sewer Improvement District 13-11** to be published once each week for two (2) consecutive weeks in the official newspaper of the City.

That a Resolution Declaring the Necessity to make the **Water and Sewer Improvement District 13-11** described in the Engineer's Report previously filed herein shall not require a protest hearing because of the provisions of Section 40-22-15 of the North Dakota Century Code.

The motion for the adoption of the foregoing Resolution was duly seconded by Commissioner Bogar, and upon vote being taken thereon, the following Commissioners voted "AYE": Cymbaluk, Bogar, Bekkedahl, Klug and Koeser and the following voted "NAY": None. Absent and not voting: None. Whereupon said motion was declared duly passed and adopted this **23rd day of April, 2013.**
