

RESOLUTION # 14-020

A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE WILLISTON DOWNTOWN PLAN (2014) AS AN AMENDMENT TO THE WILLISTON COMPREHENSIVE PLAN (2010)

WHEREAS, The Williston City Commission is duly elected governing body for the City of Williston, and wishes to plan for orderly growth and development in the Downtown area,

WHEREAS, the Williston City commission recognizes the importance of the downtown to the city of Williston; and

WHEREAS, the planning process for these undertakings was guided by a Steering committee composed of a cross-section of local officials, technical experts, and local business owners, including public officials, elected officials, planning commissioners; and

WHEREAS, public and private organizations representing numerous interests, as well as individual residents and property owners were invited, encouraged, and involved in the preparation of these plans; and

WHEREAS, the Williston Downtown Plan provides a comprehensive, coordinated program of projects and strategies that allow for ordered growth and development to create a vibrant, livable downtown that is vital to the community,


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of City Commissioners of the City of Williston, North Dakota, does hereby adopt the Williston Downtown Plan (2014).
