

RESOLUTION # 14 - 030

RESOLUTION DISCONTINUING AND VACATING A THIRTY FOOT RIGHT-OF-WAY IN THE UNPLATTED TRACT OF LAND, PARCEL ID 01798540121085, LYING IN THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 21, TOWNSHIP 154 NORTH, RANGE 101 WEST OF THE 5TH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, CITY OF WILLISTON, WILLIAMS COUNTY, NORTH DAKOTA.

The following Resolution was offered by Commissioner CYMBALUK and seconded by Commissioner BROSTUEN, who moved its adoption.

WHEREAS, The City of Williston, on the 27th day of May, 2014, entertained a request to vacate and discontinue a thirty foot right-of-way in the Unplatted Tract of Land, Parcel ID 01798540121085, lying in the Southwest Quarter of Section 21, Township 154 North, Range 101 West of the 5th Principal Meridian, City of Williston, Williams County, North Dakota, more particularly shown in Exhibit "A".

WHEREAS, vacation and discontinuance of the ten foot utility easement was no longer needed in the Unplatted Tract of Land, Parcel ID 01798540121085 as the property owner agreed to and shall dedicate a thirty foot right-of-way upon the easterly border of the Unplatted Tract of Land, more particularly described in Exhibit "B", and

WHEREAS, it appeared to the Board of City Commissioners of the City of Williston, North Dakota that said Petition should in all things be granted.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of City Commissioners of the City of Williston, North Dakota, to wit:

THAT the thirty foot right-of-way in the Unplatted Tract of Land, Parcel ID 01798540121085, lying in the Southwest Quarter of Section 21, Township 154 North, Range 101 West of the 5th Principal Meridian, City of Williston, Williams County, North Dakota, more particularly shown in Exhibit "A", is hereby in all things vacated and discontinued.
