

## RESOLUTION NO. 15-015

Commissioner PIESIK introduced the following Resolution and moved its adoption:

### RESOLUTION DECLARING NECESSITY OF AN IMPROVEMENT IN **STREET IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 15-9.**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF WILLISTON, NORTH DAKOTA:

That the Board of City Commissioners has received the Engineer's Report for the **STREET IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 15-9** and determines that it is necessary to make the following improvements:

- a. Section 1—Constructing a Mill & Overlay on 1<sup>st</sup> Ave E and 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave E from Front St. to Broadway, 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave E from 1<sup>st</sup> St to Broadway and Front St from Main to 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue E.
- b. Section 2—Constructing a Mill & Overlay on University Avenue from 1<sup>st</sup> St to Broadway and 2<sup>nd</sup> St. from Univ. Ave to 7<sup>th</sup> Ave E.
- c. Section 3—Construct a Mill & Overlay on 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Ave E from 6<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> St and on 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup> & 9<sup>th</sup> St from Main to Univ. Ave.
- d. Section 4—Construct a new asphalt alley in Block 3 of the Marmon Addition.
- e. Section 5—Construct a new asphalt alley between Block 2 Of the Briarwood Amended Subdivision and Block 4 of the Brookshire Addition.

That the boundaries of said improvement District are as follows:

- a. Section 1—All of Block 9; Lots 1 through 4 and Lots 6 through 11 of Block 10; the East 47 feet 10 inches of Lots 1 through 5 and all of Lots 6 through 12 of Block 15; all of Block 16; all of Block 17; Lots 1 through 19 of Block 18 and all of Block 21 of the Original Town Site; all of Block 1 of the Rearrangement of Block 22 of the Original Town Site; Lots 7 through 12 of Block 22 of the Bruegger's Amended Addition; Lots 1 and 2, the west half of Lot 3 and Lots 4 through 8 and Lot 12 of Block 23; the West 25 feet of Lot 3 and all of Lots 4 through 6 including the adjacent vacated alley of Block 24, all Lot 2R of the Rearrangement of Lots 1, 2, the west 25 feet of Lot 3, Lots 7 through 12 and Out Lot One of Block 24 and the East 75 feet of Lot 1 and all of Lots 2 through 12 of Block 25 of Bruegger's 2nd Addition; and the west 65 feet of Lot 1 and all of Lots 2 through 6 of Block 37 of Bruegger's 6th Addition.
- b. Section 2—Lots 1 through 6 and Lots 11 and 12 of Block 9 and Lots 1 through 4 of Block 14 of Bruegger's Amended Addition; Lots 5, 6, 9R, 10, 11 and 11R of the Bruegger's Rearrangement of the West 208 feet of Block 14 of the Bruegger's Amended Addition; all of Blocks 10 and 11 of Bruegger's 2nd Addition; all of Blocks 30, 31, 32 and 33 and Lots 1 through 7 and Lots 11 and 12 of Block 34 of Bruegger's 3rd Addition; all of Block 35 of Bruegger's 4th Addition; Lot 1 and Lots 7 through 12 of Block 37 of Bruegger's 5th Addition; all of Block 38 Lots 1 through 5, the south 90 feet of Lots 6 and 7, and Lots 8 through 15 of Block 39, all of Block 40 and all of Block 41 of the Bruegger's 7th Addition; the east 85 feet of Lots 1 and 2 and all of Lots 3 through 20 of Block 42, and Lots 1 through 14 of Block 43 of the Bruegger's 8th Addition; and all of Block 1, all of Block 2 and Lots 1 through 12 of Block 3 of the Leonhardy Addition.
- c. Section 3—Lot 1R and 2R of the Rearrangement of Lots 1, 2, the west 25 feet of Lot 3, Lots 7 through 12 and Out Lot One of Block 24 of Bruegger's 2nd Addition; the east 86 feet of Lot 1 and all of Lots 2 through 6 of Block 37 of Bruegger's 6th Addition; all of the Olson Addition; Lots 1 through 3 and Lots 22 through 32 of Block 1 and Lots 1 through 14 of Block 2 of the Ruetten Addition.

- d. Section 4—Block 3 of the Marmon Addition.
- e. Section 5—Lots 1, 2 & 3 of Block 2 of the Briarwood Subdivision and Lots 1 through 4 of the Brookshire Addition.

As shown on the attached map.

That the City Auditor is hereby authorized and directed to cause the Resolution Declaring Necessity of an improvement in **STREET IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 15-9** to be published once each week for two (2) consecutive weeks in the official newspaper of the City.

And the owners of property within said improvement district be afforded an opportunity to file written protests with the City Auditor at any time within 30 days after the first publication of the Resolution. The Board of City Commissioners shall meet to hear and to determine the sufficiency of any protests that are filed with the City Auditor prior to **March 24, 2015** at 6:00 p.m. at City Hall, in the Commission Room.

The motion for the adoption of the foregoing Resolution was duly seconded by Commissioner CYMBALUK, and upon vote being taken thereon, the following Commissioners voted "AYE": Cymbaluk, Brostuen, Piesik, Klug

and the following voted "NAY": NONE

Absent and not voting: Bekkedahl. Whereupon said motion was declared duly passed and adopted this **9<sup>th</sup> Day of February, 2015**.
