

**RESOLUTION 15-020**

**A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE WILLISTON DOWNTOWN PARKING STUDY (2015) AS AN ADDENDUM TO THE WILLISTON DOWNTOWN PLAN (2014), WHICH WAS ADOPTED AS AN AMENDMENT TO THE WILLISTON COMPREHENSIVE PLAN (2010)**

**WHEREAS**, The Williston City Commission is duly elected governing body for the City of Williston, and wishes to plan for orderly growth and development in the Downtown area,

**WHEREAS**, the Williston City Commission recognizes the importance of the downtown to the city of Williston, and

**WHEREAS**, the planning process for these undertakings was guided by a Steering committee composed of a cross-section of local officials, technical experts, and local business owners, including public officials, elected officials, planning commissioners; and

**WHEREAS**, public and private organizations representing numerous interests, as well as individual residents and property owners were invited, encouraged, and involved in the preparation of these plans; and

**WHEREAS**, the Williston Downtown Parking Study provides a comprehensive, coordinated program of projects and strategies that allow for improved parking to create a vibrant, livable downtown that is vital to the community.

**WHEREAS**, the Williston Downtown Parking Study was undertaken in the summer of 2014, and after recommendation for further study of the future parking needs of Downtown Williston it is now being recommended be adopted as an addendum to the March 2014 Downtown Plan, which was adopted by the City Commission as an amendment to the Williston Comprehensive Plan, and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of City Commissioners of the City of Williston, North Dakota, does hereby adopt the Williston Downtown Parking Study as an addendum to the Williston Downtown Plan (2014), which was an amendment to the Williston Comprehensive Plan (2010).

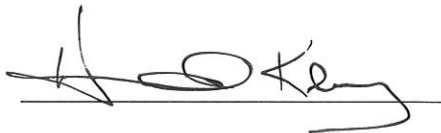
