## **RESOLUTION NO. 15-026**

Commissioner Bekkedahl introduced the following Resolution and moved its adoption:

RESOLUTION DECLARING NECESSITY OF AN IMPROVEMENT IN WATER, SEWER and STREET IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 15-10.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF WILLISTON, NORTH DAKOTA:

That the Board of City Commissioners has received the Engineer's Report for the WATER, SEWER and STREET IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 15-10 and determines that it is necessary to make the following improvements:

The Reconstruction of 16<sup>th</sup> Avenue West from 50<sup>th</sup> Street to 58<sup>th</sup> Street.

That the boundaries of said improvement District are as follows:

The SE¼ of the NW¼, the SW¼ of the NW¼, and the NW¼ of the NW¼ of Section 2, T154N, R101W of the 5<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian and the unplatted portion of the NE ¼ of Section 3, T154N, R101W of the 5th Principal Meridian lying between the Ironwood Industrial Park Subdivision and the east line of said Section 3.

As shown on the attached map.

That the City Auditor is hereby authorized and directed to cause the Resolution Declaring Necessity of an improvement in **WATER**, **SEWER** and **STREET IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 15-10** to be published once each week for two (2) consecutive weeks in the official newspaper of the City.

And the owners of property within said improvement district be afforded an opportunity to file written protests with the City Auditor at any time within 30 days after the first publication of the Resolution. The Board of City Commissioners shall meet to hear and to determine the sufficiency of any protests that are filed with the City Auditor prior to **April 14**<sup>th</sup>, **2015** at 6:00 p.m. at City Hall, in the Commission Room.

The motion for the adoption of the foregoing Resolution was duly seconded by Commissioner Cymbaluk, and upon vote being taken thereon, the following Commissioners voted "AYE": Bekkedahl, Piesik, Cymbaluk and Klug; and the following voted "NAY": none. Absent and not voting: Brostuen. Whereupon, said motion was declared duly passed and adopted this 3<sup>rd</sup> Day of March, 2015.
