

RESOLUTION NO. 15-055

The City Auditor presented to the Board of City Commissioners a certificate as to the sufficiency of protests on the proposed improvements benefitting **STREET IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 15-5**, which certificate was examined, found to be satisfactory, and ordered to be placed on file.

Commissioner Cymbaluk introduced the following Resolution and moved its adoption:


RESOLUTION AS TO PROTESTS ON PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT BENEFITTING STREET IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 15-5.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of City Commissioners of the City of Williston, North Dakota, that the Resolution of Necessity for the improvement benefitting **STREET IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 15-5** has been published in accordance with law, providing for the determination of the sufficiency of the protests at the meeting of the Board of City Commissioners held this date, and it is determined that:

1. Written protests **HAVE NOT** been filed with the City Auditor by the owners of a majority of the area of property within the district, within 30 days from the first publication of the resolution, and the Board of City Commissioners is authorized by NDCC 40-22-18 to cause the improvement to be made and to contract or otherwise provide for the construction thereof and the acquisition of any property required in connection therewith, and to levy and collect special assessments therefor.
2. Written protests **HAVE** been filed with the City Auditor by the owners of a majority of the area of property within Section II of the district, within 30 days from the first publication of the resolution, and the Board of City Commissioners is **BARRED** by NDCC 40-22-18 to cause the improvement to be made and to contract or otherwise provide for the construction thereof and the acquisition of any property required in connection therewith, and to levy and collect special assessments therefor

The motion for the adoption of the foregoing Resolution was duly seconded by Commissioner Brostuen, and upon vote being taken thereon, the following Commissioners voted "AYE": Brostuen, Bekkedahl, Piesik, Cymbaluk and Klug; and the following voted "NAY": none. Absent and not voting: none. Whereupon said motion was declared duly passed and adopted this **24th Day of March, 2015**.
