

RESOLUTION NO. 15-091

Commissioner Brostuen introduced the following Resolution and moved its adoption:

RESOLUTION DIRECTING ENGINEER FOR THE CITY OF WILLISTON TO PREPARE A REPORT AS TO THE GENERAL NATURE, PURPOSE, AND FEASIBILITY OF THE PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT AND AN ESTIMATE AS TO THE PROBABLE COST OF WORK FOR STREET IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 15-14.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF WILLISTON, NORTH DAKOTA:

That the City Engineer for the City of Williston, North Dakota, prepare a report as the general nature, purpose, and feasibility of the proposed improvement and an estimate of the probable cost of the work for **STREET IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 15-14** created for the purpose of:

Constructing concrete pavement along 84th Street (previously called 56th Street,) Energy Street and 135th Avenue NW and constructing a stabilized base with an aggregate chip seal along Oil and Derrick Avenue and Well Street in the Bakken Industrial Park.

The motion for the adoption of the foregoing Resolution was duly seconded by Commissioner Cymbaluk, and upon vote being taken thereon, the following Commissioners voted "AYE": Brostuen, Bekkedahl, Piesik, Cymbaluk and Klug and the following voted "NAY": None.
