

**RESOLUTION NO. 15-119**

Commissioner Piesik introduced the following Resolution and moved its adoption:

**RESOLUTION DECLARING NECESSITY OF AN IMPROVEMENT IN WATER, SEWER AND STREET IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 15-17.**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF WILLISTON, NORTH DAKOTA:

That the Board of City Commissioners has received the Engineer's Report for the **WATER, SEWER AND STREET IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 15-17** and determines that it is necessary to make the following improvements:

Constructing water, sewer, street and drainage improvements along 11<sup>th</sup> Street West between 32<sup>nd</sup> and 139<sup>th</sup> Avenue West.

That the boundaries of said improvement District are as follows:

Blocks One, Two, Three, Four, Lots 1 to 14 of Block Five, Lots 1 to 7 of Block 6 and Lots 1 to 5 of Block Seven of the Hawkeye Village Subdivision; Block 3 of the Sand Creek Town Centre Subdivision and Block Two of the Skyline Subdivision.

As shown on the attached map.

That the City Auditor is hereby authorized and directed to cause the Resolution Declaring Necessity of an improvement in **WATER, SEWER AND STREET IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 15-17** to be published once each week for two (2) consecutive weeks in the official newspaper of the City.

That a Resolution Declaring the Necessity to make the **WATER, SEWER AND STREET IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 15-17** described in the Engineer's Report previously filed herein shall not require a protest hearing because of the provisions of Section 40-22-15 of the North Dakota Century Code.

The motion for the adoption of the foregoing Resolution was duly seconded by Commissioner Brostuen, and upon vote being taken thereon, the following Commissioners voted "AYE": Piesik, Brostuen and Klug and the following voted "NAY": None. Absent and not voting: Bekkedahl and Cymbaluk. Whereupon said motion was declared duly passed and adopted this **26<sup>th</sup> Day of May, 2015**.
