

RESOLUTION # 15-133

A RESOLUTION TO ORDINANCE 1019 OF THE WILLISTON CODE OF ORDINANCES TO ESTABLISH A SURETY BOND AMOUNT FOR FROZEN DESSERT VENDING

Commissioner Cymbaluk introduced the following Resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, the City of Williston has previously enacted an ordinance to regulate frozen dessert vending; AND

WHEREAS, Section 18-66 of said ordinance requires applicants for licensure to deposit a surety bond with the City Auditor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Williston as follows:


The City of Williston hereby adopts as its policy regarding frozen dessert vending the following surety bond amount for the necessary licensure of ice cream trucks as required by Section 18-66 of Ordinance No. 1019:

Upon approval of the application for an ice cream truck permit, the applicant for permit shall furnish and file with the City Auditor a surety bond in the amount of \$1000 issued by a surety company licensed to do business in the State of North Dakota and approved by the City Auditor.

The motion for the adoption of the foregoing Resolution was duly seconded by Commissioner Brostuen. **ON ROLL CALL VOTE**, the following Commissioners vote "AYE": Piesik, Cymbaluk, Brostuen, Bekkedahl and Klug; and the following Commissioners vote "NAY": None; Absent and not voting: None.
