## **RESOLUTION NO. 15-140**

Commissioner Brostuen introduced the following Resolution and moved its adoption:

RESOLUTION DECLARING NECESSITY OF AN IMPROVEMENT IN ALLEY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 15-19.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF WILLISTON, NORTH DAKOTA:

That the Board of City Commissioners has received the Engineer's Report for the **ALLEY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 15-19** and determines that it is necessary to make the following improvements:

SECTION I: Pave the alleys in Block 5 of the Barnfather Addition and Block 14 of the Westlawn Addition.

SECTION II: Mill and Overlay the alley in Block 8 of the Bruegger Amended addition.

SECTION III: Grading and graveling of the alley between Block 1 of the Foxglen Subdivision and The Rachel's Subdivision.

That the boundaries of said improvement District are as follows:

Section I: Lots 1-10 of Block 14 of the Westlawn Addition and Lots 1-6 of the Barnfather Addition.

Section II: Lots 1-12 of Block 8 in the Bruegger's Amended Addition.

Section III: Lots 1R-6R of Rachel's Subdivision and Lots 3R, 4R and 13-17 of Fox Glen subdivision.

As shown on the attached maps.

That the City Auditor is hereby authorized and directed to cause the Resolution Declaring Necessity of an improvement in **ALLEY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 15-19** to be published once each week for two (2) consecutive weeks in the official newspaper of the City.

FOR SECTION I: That a Resolution Declaring the Necessity to make the **ALLEY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 15-19** described in the Engineer's Report previously filed herein shall not require a protest hearing for SECTION I because of the provisions of Section 40-22-15 of the North Dakota Century Code.

FOR SECTIONS II & III: That the owners of property within said improvement district SECTIONS II & III be afforded an opportunity to file written protests with the City Auditor at any time within 30 days after the first publication of the Resolution. The Board of City Commissioners shall meet to hear and to determine the sufficiency of any protests that are filed with the City Auditor prior to **August 25th, 2015 at 6:00 p.m.** at City Hall, in the Commission Room.

The motion for the adoption of the foregoing Resolution was duly seconded by Commissioner Piesik, and upon vote being taken thereon, the following Commissioners voted "AYE": Piesik, Cymbaluk, Brostuen and Klug and the following voted "NAY": None. Absent and not voting: Bekkedahl. Whereupon said motion was declared duly passed and adopted this 14<sup>th</sup> Day of July, 2015.
