

RESOLUTION NO. 15-154

Commissioner Bekkedahl introduced the following Resolution and moved its adoption:

RESOLUTION DECLARING NECESSITY OF AN IMPROVEMENT IN DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 15-8.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF WILLISTON, NORTH DAKOTA:

That the Board of City Commissioners has received the Engineer's Report for the **DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 15-8** and determines that it is necessary to make the following improvements:

Providing drainage improvements to control spring water flows being discharged from the Schlumberger Campus into the right of way of US Highway 2 & 85.

That the boundaries of said improvement District are as follows:

Sublot 1R of the unplatted portion of Section 20, T154N, R101W.

As shown on the attached map.

That the City Auditor is hereby authorized and directed to cause the Resolution Declaring Necessity of an improvement in **DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 15-8** to be published once each week for two (2) consecutive weeks in the official newspaper of the City.

That a Resolution Declaring the Necessity to make the **DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 15-8** described in the Engineer's Report previously filed herein shall not require a protest hearing because of the provisions of Section 40-22-15 of the North Dakota Century Code.

The motion for the adoption of the foregoing Resolution was duly seconded by Commissioner Cymbaluk, and upon vote being taken thereon, the following Commissioners voted "AYE": Bekkedahl, Piesik, Cymbaluk, Brostuen and Klug and the following voted "NAY": None. Absent and not voting: None. Whereupon said motion was declared duly passed and adopted this **22nd day of September, 2015**.
