## **RESOLUTION 16-023**

RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE DEDICATION OF LOT 4, MICHAEL J. WELLS SUBDIVISION, CITY OF WILLISTON, WILLIAMS COUNTY, NORTH DAKOTA.

WHEREAS, the dedication of the above-described Lot 4 is in the City of Williston's best interests as the dedication will help enable the City of Williston to plan and ensure there is adequate drainage in the area of this property,

WITNESSETH, that said Grantor, being the Owner of the property described as Lot 4 of the Michael J. Wells Subdivision. Williston, ND, excepting and reserving unto Grantor all oil, gas and all other minerals of whatsoever nature or kind in and under and that may be produced from said property, together with the right of ingress and egress thereto for the purpose of exploring for, drilling, mining, storing and transporting the same, and granting to the City a 60-foot wide access easement on behalf of Lot 2, hereby voluntarily consents and dedicates to said Grantee, their successors and assigns, a public right of way for the above described property which is more fully described in the attached Exhibit "A". (Exhibit A to include a drawing of the dedicated area and the legal description)

This Dedication of Public Right-of-Way dedicates to Grantee and the Public, their successors and assigns, the above-described Property to the Public for their use forever.

Further, this Dedication of Public Right-of-Way shall be only for the property described and illustrated in Exhibit A and not any other part of the Grantor's property.

The dedication, grant, and other provisions of this Agreement shall constitute a covenant running with the land for the benefit of the Grantee and the Public forever.
