

RESOLUTION NO. 17-018

Commissioner Cymbaluk introduced the following Resolution and moved its adoption:

RESOLUTION DIRECTING ENGINEER FOR THE CITY OF WILLISTON TO PREPARE A REPORT AS TO THE GENERAL NATURE, PURPOSE, AND FEASIBILITY OF THE PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT AND AN ESTIMATE AS TO THE PROBABLE COST OF WORK FOR STREET IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 17-3.


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF WILLISTON, NORTH DAKOTA:

That the City Engineer for the City of Williston, North Dakota, prepare a report as the general nature, purpose, and feasibility of the proposed improvement and an estimate of the probable cost of the work for **STREET IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 17-3** created for the purpose of:

- Section 1: Construction of a Perm-Enzyme road surface along 84th Street going east from 13th Avenue East ¼ mile to the City Limits.
- Section 2: Construction of a Perm-Enzyme road surface along 26th Avenue Northeast and 27th Avenue East going north from Halliburton Drive to County Road 9.

The motion for the adoption of the foregoing Resolution was duly seconded by Commissioner Brostuen, and upon vote being taken thereon, the following Commissioners voted "AYE": Cymbaluk, Brostuen, Piesik, and Klug and the following voted "NAY": None. Absent and not voting: Bekkedahl. Whereupon said motion was declared duly passed and adopted this **28th Day of March, 2017**.
