

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A SURCHARGE FOR SEWER UTILITY SERVICE, OPERATION, MAINTENANCE, AND REPLACEMENT OF A SEWER LIFT STATION

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF WILLISTON, NORTH DAKOTA:

WHEREAS, the City of Williston requires a sewer lift station and desires to assess the payment of operation, maintenance and replacement costs to each user receiving benefits from said sewer lift station, as a surcharge to be added to the normal monthly bill for water, sewer and garbage utility service, affecting the following described real property, situated in the City of Williston, Williams County, North Dakota, to-wit:

That portion of land located within the City Limits of Williston, North Dakota located east of the Little Muddy River.

and,

WHEREAS, it appears to be to the mutual benefit of the City of Williston and the users affected that such surcharge be established,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS of the City of Williston, North Dakota, that there is hereby established a surcharge for sewer utility service, operation, maintenance and replacement of a sewer lift station located in the above described real property in the City of Williston, North Dakota, and that the surcharge be determined by the Director of Public Works in accordance with regulations promulgated by him and addressing the operation costs, the maintenance costs and the replacement costs of such lift station.

Commissioner Underhill introduced the Resolution and Commissioner Lawson seconded the Resolution. Upon roll call vote, the following Commissioners voted "AYE": Underhill, Lawson, Bogar, Bekkedah, Koeser, and the following voted "NAY":
