

RESOLUTION NO. 08-25

A resolution encouraging the Citizens of Williston to support the Williston Vector Control Board ballot measure request for additional revenue to expand mosquito control efforts in and around the City.

Whereas, Williston is fortunate to have had volunteers and staff willing to accept the positions of responsibility for the control of local mosquito populations; and,

Whereas, the City Commission works with this Board and Staff to find and provide funding to alleviate the mosquito problems; and,

Whereas, the City and Vector Control Board continue to pursue significant Federal funding to assist in its management efforts, particularly in the area held by the Corps of Engineers south of the City; and,


Whereas, the presence and size of the mosquito population is a detriment to our local quality of life; and,

Whereas, the Vector Control Board is now coordinating assistance efforts provided by the United States Air Force Reserve to aerial larvacide and possibly adulticide the City for the summer of 2009;


Now, Therefore, be it resolved, that the Board of City Commissioners of Williston, North Dakota do hereby endorse a YES vote by its citizens on the mosquito ballot measure on November 4, 2008.
