BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of City Commissioners of the City of Williston, North Dakota, that the Resolution of Necessity for the improvement benefiting **Street And Alley Improvement District 09-3** has been published in accordance with law, providing for the determination of the sufficiency of the protests at the meeting of the Board of City Commissioners held this date, and it is determined that written protests have not been filed with the City Auditor by the owners of a majority of the area of property within the district, within 30 days from the first publication of the resolution, and the Board of City Commissioners is authorized by NDCC 40-22-18 to cause the improvement to be made and to contract or otherwise provide for the construction thereof and the acquisition of any property required in connection therewith, and to levy and collect special assessments therefor.

The motion for the adoption of the foregoing Resolution was duly seconded by Commissioner Bogar, and upon vote being taken thereon, the following Commissioners voted "AYE": Bekkedahl, Klug, Lawson, Bogar, Koeser and the following voted "NAY": None
