

Resolution No. 09-42


That the City Auditor is hereby authorized and ordered to cause this Resolution to be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the official newspaper of the City of Williston.

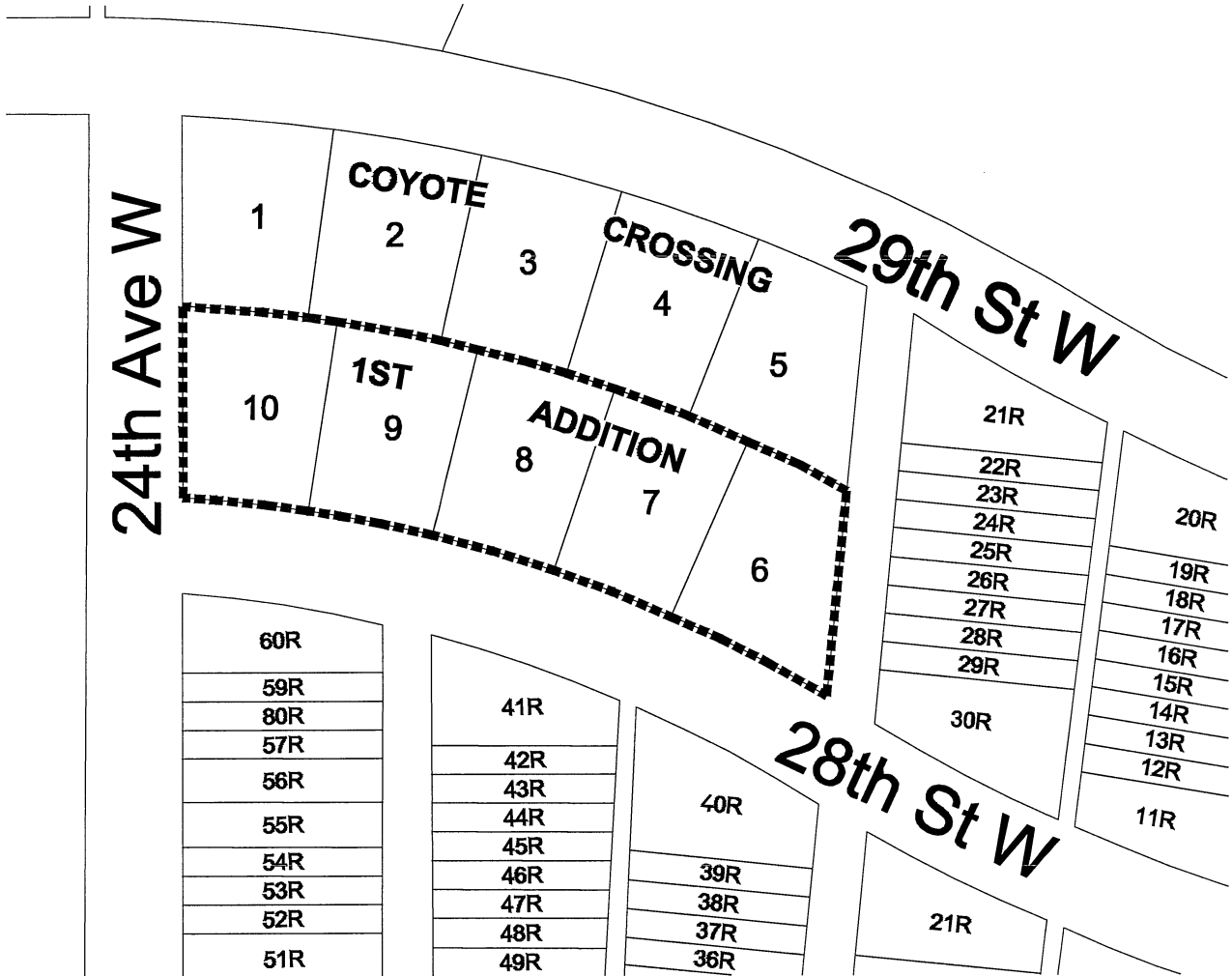
