

## **RESOLUTION NO. 10-21**

### A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A POLICY REGARDING SALES OF SUPPLIES AND RENTAL OF EQUIPMENT TO INDIVIDUALS OR COMPANIES

WHEREAS, The City of Williston keeps an inventory of supplies and equipment for its own use; and

WHEREAS, Many of these supplies and equipment are of a specialized nature and not readily available; and

WHEREAS, Occasionally it is in the City of Williston's interest to sell supplies or rent equipment to other government agencies or to the general public;
