Commissioner Klug introduced the following Resolution and moved its adoption:


RESOLUTION DIRECTING ENGINEER FOR THE CITY OF WILLISTON TO PREPARE A REPORT AS TO THE GENERAL NATURE, PURPOSE, AND FEASIBILITY OF THE PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT AND AN ESTIMATE AS TO THE PROBABLE COST OF WORK FOR **AMENDED STREET AND ALLEY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 10-3**.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF WILLISTON, NORTH DAKOTA:


That the City Engineer for the City of Williston, North Dakota, prepare a report as the general nature, purpose, and feasibility of the proposed improvement and an estimate of the probable cost of the work for **AMENDED STREET AND ALLEY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 10-3**, which is an improvement project consisting of **Water, Sewer, and Street Improvements in:**

Section V: The installation of a Water System, Sewer System, and Asphalt Surfacing along 24th Street West between 9th and 11th Avenues West and along 11th Avenue West from Knoll Street to 24th Street.

The motion for the adoption of the foregoing Resolution was duly seconded by Commissioner Lawson , and upon vote being taken thereon, the following Commissioners voted "AYE": Bekkedahl, Klug, Lawson, Koeser and the following voted "NAY": None Absent and not voting Bogar .
