

RESOLUTION NO. 10-32

Commissioner Lawson introduced the following Resolution and moved its adoption:

RESOLUTION DECLARING NECESSITY OF AN IMPROVEMENT IN STREET IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 10-4

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF WILLISTON, NORTH DAKOTA:

That the Board of City Commissioners has received the Engineer's Report for the **STREET IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 10-4**, and determines that it is necessary to make the improvements on:

32nd Street West from Pheasant Run Parkway west to the Williston City Limits

That the boundaries of said Improvement District are as follows:

The north 150 feet of the Bakken Heights Subdivision; the south 150 feet of Block 19 including the vacated portion of 21st Avenue West, the south 150 feet of Block 21 including the vacated portion of 21st Avenue West, the south 150 feet of Block 23 including the vacated portion of 24th Avenue West and the south 150 feet of Block 24 including the vacated portions of 24th Avenue west and 25th Court of the Pheasant Run 1st Subdivision and the south 150 feet of Block 6 of the Sand Creek Estates Subdivision.

As shown on the attached drawing.

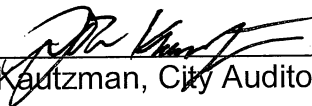
That the Board of City Commissioners has received written petitions signed by the owners of a majority of the area of the property included within the district requesting the improvements described in the Engineer's report previously filed herein.

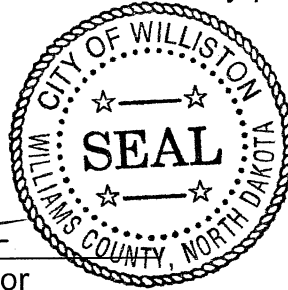
That a Resolution Declaring the Necessity to make the improvements described in the Engineer's Report previously filed here in shall not require a protest hearing because of the written petitions received by the Board of City Commissioners as allowed by the provisions of Section 40-22-15 of the North Dakota Century Code.


That the City Auditor is hereby authorized and directed to cause the Resolution Declaring Necessity of an improvement in **STREET IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 10-4** to be published once each week for two (2) consecutive weeks in the official newspaper of the City.

The motion for the adoption of the foregoing Resolution was duly seconded by Commissioner Klug, and upon vote being taken thereon, the following Commissioners voted AYE: Klug, Lawson, Koeser and the following voted NAY: None Absent and not voting: Bekkedahl, Bogar. Whereupon said motion was declared duly passed and adopted this 21st day of June, 2010.
