

RESOLUTION NO. 10-38

RESOLUTION DIRECTING ENGINEER FOR THE CITY OF WILLISTON TO PREPARE A REPORT AS TO THE GENERAL NATURE, PURPOSE, AND FEASIBILITY OF THE PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT AND AN ESTIMATE AS TO THE PROBABLE COST OF WORK FOR **WATER AND SEWER IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 10-5.**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF WILLISTON, NORTH DAKOTA:

That the City Engineer for the City of Williston, North Dakota, prepare a report as the general nature, purpose, and feasibility of the proposed improvement and an estimate of the probable cost of the work for **WATER AND SEWER IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 10-5**, which is an improvement project consisting of **Water and Sewer Improvements on:**

23rd Street from 19th Avenue West to the west edge of the Timbers Subdivision
