

RESOLUTION 10-44

A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE WILLISTON COMPREHENSIVE PLAN (2010),
TRANSPORTATION PLAN (2010), AND US HIGHWAY 2 CORRIDOR STUDY (2010).

WHEREAS, the Williston City Commission is the duly elected governing body for the City of Williston, and wishes to plan for orderly future growth and development and a safe and functional transportation system; and

WHEREAS, the Williston City Commission recognizes the importance of the US Highway 2 Corridor to the transportation system within the City of Williston; and

WHEREAS, the Williston City Commission has undertaken the task of updating its Comprehensive Plan and Transportation Plan, and completing a study of the US Highway 21 Corridor, which are vital elements of the planning process; and

WHEREAS, the Williston City Commission wishes to cooperate with Williams County to achieve their mutual planning and transportation objectives; and

WHEREAS, the planning process for these undertakings was guided by a Planning Advisory Committee composed of a wide cross-section of local officials and technical experts including public officials, elected officials, planning commissioners, and agency representatives; and

WHEREAS, public and private organizations representing numerous interests, as well as individual residents and property owners were invited, encouraged, and involved in the preparation of these Plans; and

WHEREAS, the Williston Comprehensive Plan (2010), the Williston Transportation Plan (2010), and the US Highway 2 Corridor Study (2010) provide a comprehensive, coordinated program of projects and strategies that will allow for orderly growth and development and that will improve the urban and extraterritorial transportation system of the Williston area.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of the City of Williston does hereby adopt the Williston Comprehensive Plan (2010), the Williston Transportation Plan (2010), and the US Highway 2 Corridor Plan (2010).

Commissioner Bogar moved the adoption of the foregoing resolution. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Bekkedahl. On roll call vote of the Commissioners, the following Commissioners voted "AYE": Klug, Cymbaluk, Bogar, Bekkedahl, Koeser and the following Commissioners voted "NAY": None.
