

**RESOLUTION NO. 10-47**

RESOLUTION DIRECTING ENGINEER FOR THE CITY OF WILLISTON TO PREPARE A REPORT AS TO THE GENERAL NATURE, PURPOSE, AND FEASIBILITY OF THE PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT AND AN ESTIMATE AS TO THE PROBABLE COST OF WORK FOR **STREET IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 10-6**.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF WILLISTON, NORTH DAKOTA:

That the City Engineer for the City of Williston, North Dakota, prepare a report as the general nature, purpose, and feasibility of the proposed improvement and an estimate of the probable cost of the work for **STREET IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 10-6**, which is an improvement project consisting of **Curb, Gutter and Paving on:**


29<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Chokecherry Street, 27<sup>th</sup> Avenue, and 23<sup>rd</sup> Street in the Granite Peak Subdivision Phase I & II.
