RESOLUTION DECLARING NECESSITY OF AN IMPROVEMENT IN **STREET IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 10-6**.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF WILLISTON, NORTH DAKOTA:

1. That the Board of City Commissioners has received the Engineer's Report for the STREET IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 10-6, and determines that it is necessary to make Curb, Gutter and Paving Improvements on:

29th Avenue, Chokecherry Street, 27th Avenue, and 23rd Street in the Granite Peak Subdivsion Phase I & II.

2. That the boundaries of said improvement District are as follows:

Lots 1 to 4, Block 1; Lots 1 to 12, Bock 2; Lots 1 to 12, Block 3; Lots 12, 13, 14, Block 5; Lots 1 to 24 Block 7; and Lots 1 to 4 of Block 8 of the Granite Peak Subdivision of the City of Williston, North Dakota.

As shown on the attached drawings.

- 3. That the Board of City Commissioners has received written petitions signed by the owners of a majority of the area of the property included within the district requesting the improvements described in the Engineer's report previously filed herein.
- 4. That a Resolution Declaring the Necessity to make the improvements described in the Engineer's Report previously filed here in shall not require a protest hearing because of the written petitions received by the Board of City Commissioners as allowed by the provisions of Section 40-2-22-15 of the North Dakota Century code.
- 5. That the City Auditor is hereby authorized and directed to cause the Resolution Declaring Necessity of an improvement in STREET IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 10-6 to be published once each week for two (2) consecutive weeks in the official newspaper of the city.

The motion for the adoption of the foregoing Resolution was duly seconded by Commissioner Cymbaluk, and upon vote being taken thereon, the following Commissioners voted "AYE": Bogar, Bekkedahl, Klug, Cymbaluk and Koeser and the following voted "NAY": None. Absent and not voting: None. Whereupon said motion was declared duly passed and adopted this **28th day of September 2010.**


