

**RESOLUTION NO. 11-12**

Commissioner Bogar introduced the following Resolution and moved its adoption:

**RESOLUTION CREATING 26<sup>th</sup> STREET WATER, SEWER, STORM SEWER AND STREET IMPROVEMENTS PHASE I DISTRICT 11-3 OF THE CITY OF WILLISTON, NORTH DAKOTA.**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF WILLISTON, NORTH DAKOTA:

There is hereby created an Improvement District in the City of Williston, to be designated and known as **26<sup>th</sup> STREET WATER, SEWER, STORM SEWER AND STREET IMPROVEMENTS PHASE I DISTRICT 11-3** created for the purpose constructing the following:

The construction of water, sewer, storm sewer and street improvements along 26<sup>th</sup> Street commencing at the north south ¼ line of Section 10, T154N, R101W and ending at the western north south ¼ ¼ line of said Section 10 and along 27<sup>th</sup> Avenue West commencing at 26<sup>th</sup> Street and ending at the Hagan School.


That said **26<sup>th</sup> STREET WATER, SEWER, STORM SEWER AND STREET IMPROVEMENTS PHASE I DISTRICT 11-3** shall contain and involve the following described real property situated in the City of Williston, Williams County, North Dakota, described as follows:

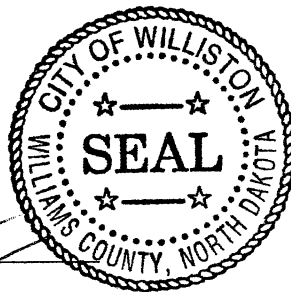
All of the Granite Peak Subdivision, all of the School Subdivision and the south 1,165 feet of the west 986 feet of the south east ¼ of the southwest ¼ of the unplatted portions of Section 10, T154N, R101W of the Fifth Principal Meridian.
