

RESOLUTION NO. 11-33

Commissioner Bogar introduced the following Resolution and moved its adoption:

RESOLUTION CREATING **WATER, SEWER, STREET & ALLEY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 11-4 OF THE CITY OF WILLISTON, NORTH DAKOTA.**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF WILLISTON, NORTH DAKOTA:

1. There is hereby created a Water and Sewer Improvement District in the City of Williston, to be designated and known as **WATER, SEWER, STREET & ALLEY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 11-4** created for the purpose constructing the following:

Section I: Paving improvements on the alley located between Main Street and 1st Avenue East from 18th and 20th Street.

Section II: Mill and asphalt overlay 22nd Avenue West between 32nd and 38th Streets West and 38th Street West from 22nd Avenue West to the west line of the Cimarron Heights Mobile Home Park.

Section III: Widen, mill and asphalt overlay West Highland Drive between 2nd and 4th Avenues West and mill and asphalt overlay West Highland Drive between 4th and 6th Avenues West.

Section IV: 11th Avenue West and 24th Street West improvements consisting of:

Part A: Install water lines along 11th Avenue West between Knoll Street and 24th Street. Install sewer lines along 11th Avenue West from Knoll Street to 24th Street and along 24th Street between 11th and 12th Avenues West.

Part B: Grade and install an aggregate base and concrete curb & gutter along 11th Avenue West from Knoll Street to 24th Street and 24th Street West between 9th and 12th Avenues West.

Part C: Paving 11th Avenue West from Knoll Street to 24th Street and 24th Street West between 9th and 12th Avenues West.

Section V: 22nd Street West improvements consisting of:

The reconstruction of 22nd Street West from 4th Avenue West going west to the North Dakota Department of Transportation maintenance yard including the installation of a 2 inch water service line and the extension of the 4th Avenue West Alley 18" Storm Sewer to 22nd Street West.

2. That said **WATER, SEWER, STREET & ALLEY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 11-4** shall contain and involve the following described real property situated in the City of Williston, Williams County, North Dakota, described as follows:

Section I—Paving Improvements on the alley located between Main Street and 1st Avenue East from 18th and 20th Street:

Block 2 of the Severtsen Rearrangement and Block 2 of the Volney 3rd Rearrangement.

Section II—22nd Avenue West and 38th Street West Mill & Overlay:

Blocks 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24 and 25 of the Pheasant Run 1st Addition.

Section III—West Highland Drive:

Lots 9 and 10 of Block 2 and Lots 7 through 12 of Block 3 of the Highland Homes 1st Addition; the south 135 feet of Plot 3 and a 143' X 100' tract and a 104' X 140' tract in Plot 4 of the Liberty Homes Addition; Block 1 of the Million Dollar Center Addition; Block 2 of the Sandvik Rearrangement and the West 350' X 179.58' tract in the SE 1/4, SE 1/4 of the unplatted portion of Section 14, T154N, R101W.

Section IV—11th Avenue West and 24th Street West:

A 102.66 foot wide strip of land laying adjacent to and south of the north lot line of Lots 1 and 2, Block 4 and all of Lots 1, 7, 8 & 9, Block 5 of the Lewison Addition; a 102.66 foot wide strip of land laying adjacent to and north of the south lot line of Lot 1R, Block 1, and Lot 7R, Block 2 of the Lewison Rearrangement; and all of Lot 1R and Lot 2R except for the southeast 144.76 feet, Block 1 of the Sundance Rearrangement.

Section V—22nd Street West Reconstruction:


Lots 11 & 12, Block 2 and Lots 1 & 2, Block 3 of the Airport 1st Addition.

As shown on the attached maps.
