That the Board of City Commissioners orders the advertisement for construction bids for **STREET IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 11-2.**



ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS
FOR
STREETIMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 11-2
Williston, North Dakota

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids for the completed construction of Street Improvement District 11-2 for City of Williston, North Dakota, will be received at the Office of the City Auditor, in the Williston City Hall, P.O. Box 1306, until 3:00 P.M., February 10, 2011. At that time, the bids will be opened in the City Commission Meeting Room at the Williston City Hall, 22 East Broadway, Williston, North Dakota, and read aloud.

The project consists of the following approximate principal quantities:

Section I—Sloulin Field Street Overlay:

21,639 SY of Profile Milling and 21,369 SY of 2" Asphalt Paving Fabric Overlay.

Section II—19th Avenue West Overlay:

5,796 SY of Profile Milling and 5,796 SY of 2" Asphalt Overlay.

Section III—10th Avenue East Overlay:

5,302 SY of Profile Milling and 5,302 SY of 2" Asphalt Paving Fabric Overlay.

The work shall be completed by October 31, 2011.

To order specifications & plans or for further information contact the Engineering Department at 809 5th Street East, P.O. Box 2437, Williston, ND 58802-2437, or call 701-577-6368. ALL BIDDERS are required to view the proposed project site area in order to familiarize themselves with the details of the area prior to submitting a bid.

Copies of the bid forms, drawings, specifications, and contract documents may be obtained from the Engineering Department for payment of a non-refundable \$25.00 fee.

Each bid is to be submitted on the basis of cash payment for the work and is to be enclosed in a sealed envelope addressed to the City Auditor. Each bid shall be accompanied by a Bidder's Bond in a sum equal to 5% of the full amount of the bid, executed by the BIDDER as principal and by a surety company authorized to do business in this State, conditioned that if the principal's bid be accepted and the contract be awarded to him, he within 10 days after Notice of Award, will execute and effect a contract in accordance with the terms of his bid and provide a Performance and Payment Bond in the amount of 100% of the Contract Price with a corporate surety approved by the Owner.

The Bid Bond and Contractor's License Renewal Certificate shall be submitted in a separate sealed envelope attached to the outside of the Bid Envelope. Bidders must be licensed for the highest amount of their bid.

Each Bid shall be marked on the outside of the envelope, the date of the proposal, the name of the Bidder, and acknowledgment of any Addendums that were received. The right is reserved to reject any or all bids, and to waive any informality in any bid and to hold bids for a period not to exceed 30 days from said date of opening of bids.
