

**RESOLUTION NO. 12-50**

Commissioner Klug introduced the following Resolution and moved its adoption:

RESOLUTION DIRECTING ENGINEER FOR THE CITY OF WILLISTON TO PREPARE A REPORT AS TO THE GENERAL NATURE, PURPOSE, AND FEASIBILITY OF THE PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT AND AN ESTIMATE AS TO THE PROBABLE COST OF WORK FOR **2012 STREET LIGHT IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 12-7**.


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF WILLISTON, NORTH DAKOTA:

That the City Engineer for the City of Williston, North Dakota, prepare a report as the general nature, purpose, and feasibility of the proposed improvement and an estimate of the probable cost of the work for **2012 STREET LIGHT IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 12-7**, which is an improvement project consisting of the following:

A Street Lighting System in the unlit portions of the City of Williston between 11th Street and 26<sup>th</sup> Street and west of 16<sup>th</sup> Avenue West.
