

RESOLUTION NO. 12-86

Commissioner Klug introduced the following Resolution and moved its adoption:

RESOLUTION DIRECTING ENGINEER FOR THE CITY OF WILLISTON TO PREPARE A REPORT AS TO THE GENERAL NATURE, PURPOSE, AND FEASIBILITY OF THE PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT AND AN ESTIMATE AS TO THE PROBABLE COST OF WORK FOR **STREET LIGHT IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 12-9**.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF WILLISTON, NORTH DAKOTA:

That the City Engineer for the City of Williston, North Dakota, prepare a report as the general nature, purpose, and feasibility of the proposed improvement and an estimate of the probable cost of the work for **STREET LIGHT IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 12-9**, which is an improvement project consisting of the following:

A new street light system along East Broadway from the Little Muddy River Bridge to the BNSF Rail Road Overpass.

The motion for the adoption of the foregoing Resolution was duly seconded by Commissioner Cymbaluk, and upon vote being taken thereon, the following Commissioners voted "AYE": Klug, Cymbaluk, Bekkedahl and the following voted "NAY": none Absent and not voting: Bogar, Koeser.
