

RESOLUTION NO. 12-88

Commissioner Klug introduced the following Resolution and moved its adoption:

RESOLUTION DECLARING NECESSITY OF AN IMPROVEMENT IN **STREET LIGHT IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 12-9.**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF WILLISTON, NORTH DAKOTA:

That the Board of City Commissioners has received the Engineer's Report for the **STREET LIGHT IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 12-9**, and determines that it is necessary to make the following improvements:

A new street light system along East Broadway from the Little Muddy River Bridge to the BNSF Rail Road Overpass.

That the boundaries of said improvement District are as follows:

The South 600 feet of Lot 1 and Lot 5 of Block 1 and Lots 1 and 3 of Block 2 of the Williston Rail Industrial Park Subdivision and all of Block 2 of the Falk Reiger Subdivision.

As shown on the attached map.

That a resolution declaring the necessity to make the Street Improvements described in the Engineer's Report previously filed herein shall require a protest hearing and that the owners of property within said improvement district be afforded an opportunity to file written protests against said improvements with the City Auditor at any time within 30 days of the first publication of this resolution. The Board of City Commissioners shall meet to hear and to determine the sufficiency of any protests that are filed with the City Auditor prior to **August 14th, 2012**, at 6:00 PM at City Hall in the Commission Room.

That the City Auditor is hereby authorized and directed to cause the Resolution Declaring Necessity of an improvement in **STREET LIGHT IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 12-9** to be published once each week for two (2) consecutive weeks in the official newspaper of the city.

The motion for the adoption of the foregoing Resolution was duly seconded by Commissioner Cymbaluk, and upon vote being taken thereon, the following Commissioners voted "AYE": Klug, Cymbaluk, Bekkedahl and the following voted "NAY": none Absent and not voting: Bogar, Koester. Whereupon said motion was declared duly passed and adopted this **10th day of July, 2012**.

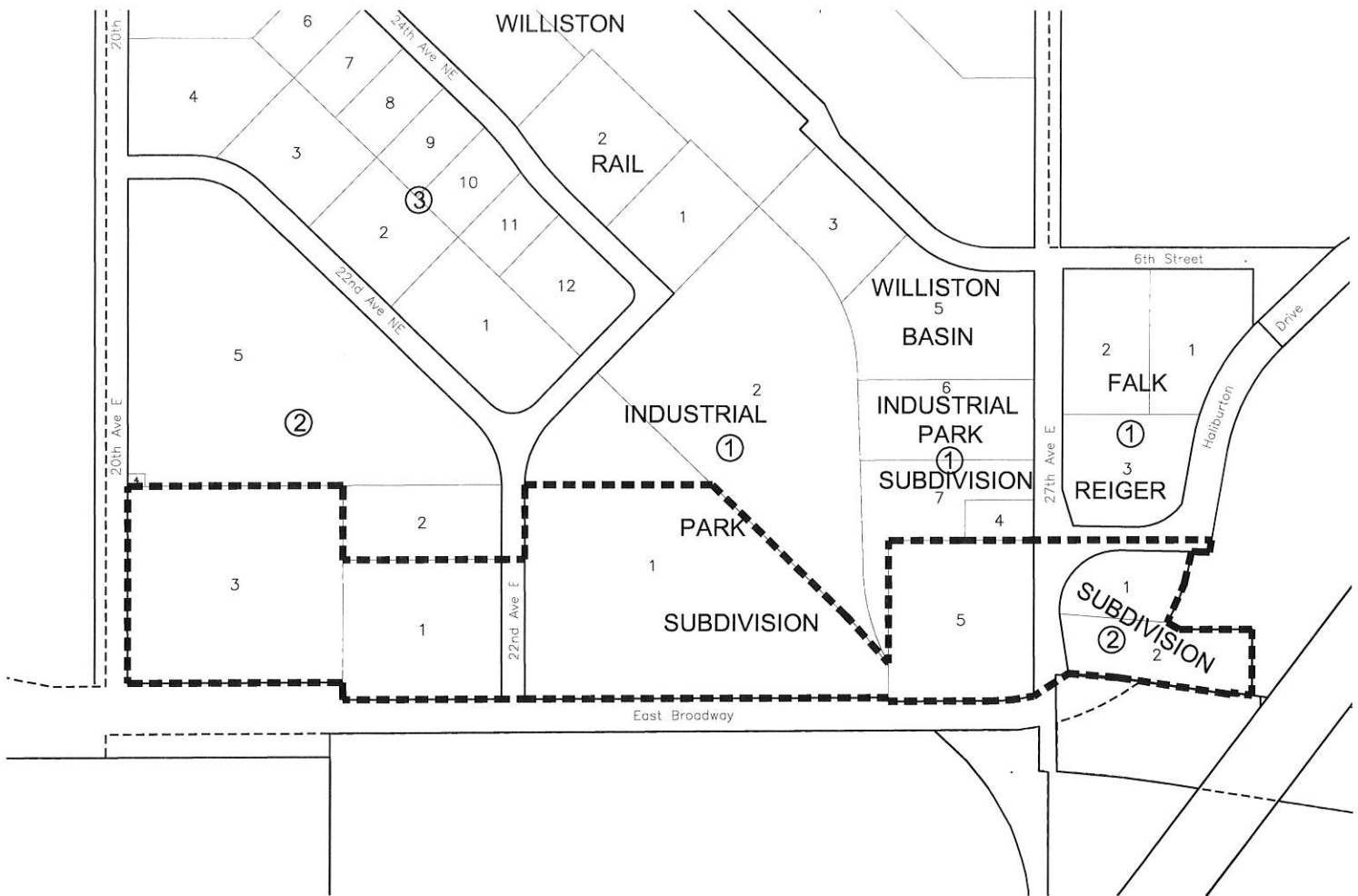
