

RESOLUTION NO. 13-096

Commissioner Bekkedahl introduced the following Resolution and moved its adoption:

RESOLUTION DIRECTING ENGINEER FOR THE CITY OF WILLISTON TO PREPARE A REPORT AS TO THE GENERAL NATURE, PURPOSE, AND FEASIBILITY OF THE PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT AND AN ESTIMATE AS TO THE PROBABLE COST OF WORK FOR **WATER AND SEWER IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 13-12**.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF WILLISTON, NORTH DAKOTA:

That the City Engineer for the City of Williston, North Dakota, prepare a report as the general nature, purpose, and feasibility of the proposed improvement and an estimate of the probable cost of the work for **Water and Sewer Improvement District 13-12** created for the purpose of:

Constructing a new water and sewer system in the Renaissance Heights Subdivision and Williston Park Subdivision. The water system will consist of 8" water mains with service lines to each lot, while the sewer system will consist of 8" sewer mains with services to each lot.

The motion for the adoption of the foregoing Resolution was duly seconded by Commissioner Bogar, and upon vote being taken thereon, the following Commissioners voted "AYE":
