

RESOLUTION NO. 14-014

Commissioner Bekkedahl introduced the following Resolution and moved its adoption:

RESOLUTION DECLARING NECESSITY OF AN IMPROVEMENT IN STREET LIGHT IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 14-3.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF WILLISTON, NORTH DAKOTA:

1. That the Board of City Commissioners has received the Engineer's Report for the **Street Light Improvement District 14-3** and determines that it is necessary to make the following improvements:

Section I: The relocation of street lights west of the Frontage Rd to the east of Frontage Rd in Block 1 and Block 4 of the Airport First Addition.

Section II: The new construction of street lights along 24th Street West of Block 1 and Block 2 of the Prairie Green Estates Subdivision.

2. That said **Street Light Improvement District 14-3** shall contain and involve the following described real property situated in the City of Williston, Williams County, North Dakota, described as follows:

Section I: The relocation of the street lights from the west side to the east side of the 2nd Avenue West Frontage Road between 19th And 26th Street.

Section II: The new construction of street lights along 24th Street West going east from 1st Avenue West.

That the City Auditor is hereby authorized and directed to cause the Resolution Declaring Necessity of an improvement in **Street Light Improvement District 14-3** to be published once each week for two (2) consecutive weeks in the official newspaper of the City.

And the owners of property within said improvement district be afforded an opportunity to file written protests with the City Auditor at any time within 30 days after the first publication of the Resolution. The Board of City Commissioners shall meet to hear and to determine the sufficiency of any protests that are filed with the City Auditor prior to **April 8th, 2014** at 6:00 p.m. at City Hall, in the Commission Room.


The motion for the adoption of the foregoing Resolution was duly seconded by Commissioner Cymbaluk, and upon vote being taken thereon, the following Commissioners voted "AYE": Brostuen, Bekkedahl, Klug, Cymbaluk and Koeser

and the following voted "NAY": None

Absent and not voting: None. Whereupon said motion was declared duly passed and adopted this **25th day of February, 2014**.
