TAXI CAB DRIVER APPLICATION

Sec 21-28.

Drivers; qualifications

A taxi company may not employ any person as a driver who does not meet the following requirements:

1. Who is under 18 years of age.
2. Who does not possess a valid North Dakota driver's license.
3. Who has been convicted of a felony, or who has been convicted of driving a vehicle while under the influence of intoxicating liquor or narcotics, unless one year has elapsed since the date of his conviction or discharge from a penal institution, whichever is later.
4. Who during any continuous one year period has been convicted of two (2) or more violations of the traffic ordinances of any city or state.
5. Who is unable to read, speak or understand English.
6. Who is not of sound physique, who has distance visual acuity of a least 20/40 (Snellen) in each eye without corrective lenses, distance binocular acuity of at least 20/40 (Snellen) in both eyes with or without corrective lenses, field of vision of at least seventy degrees in the horizontal meridian of each eye, and the ability to recognize the colors of traffic signals and devices showing standard red, green, and amber, and that the applicant has good hearing and is not subject to epilepsy, vertigo, heart trouble or other infirmity of body or mind, which might render him unfit for the safe operation of a taxicab.
7. Who is currently taking medication which might render him unfit for the safe operation of a taxicab.
8. Who has been disapproved by the chief of police or his agent under the provisions of the following. section.

Sec 21-29 Approval or Disapproval of driver—Grounds.

Any person desiring to drive a taxicab or be employed as a taxicab driver must submit an application to the chief of police. The application must include evidence of that they are qualified under Sec 21-28 of this chapter. Additionally, the applicant must also submit to a back ground check. The chief of police shall disapprove a taxicab driver if the driver:

- (1) For any reason is disqualified under section 21-28 of this article.
- (2) For the preservation of public safety, welfare, morals or good order is found by the chief of police to be unfit to drive a taxicab.

I fully understand the qualifications for a taxi cab driver and I swear that I meet these qualifications.
