

RESOLUTION NO. 15-152

RESOLUTION DIRECTING ENGINEER FOR THE CITY OF WILLISTON TO PREPARE A REPORT AS TO THE GENERAL NATURE, PURPOSE, AND FEASIBILITY OF THE PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT AND AN ESTIMATE AS TO THE PROBABLE COST OF WORK FOR **DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 15-8**.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF WILLISTON, NORTH DAKOTA:

That the City Engineer for the City of Williston, North Dakota, prepare a report as the general nature, purpose, and feasibility of the proposed improvement and an estimate of the probable cost of the work for **DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 15-8** created for the purpose of:

Providing drainage improvements to control spring water flows being discharged from the Schlumberger Campus into the right of way of US Highway 2 & 85.
