3. Public Hearings
  - A. Oakwells Commuter Rail dba Refinery Kitchen & Bar – New Alcoholic Beverage License

John Kautzman City Auditor presented the following;

They have applied for a Specialty Airport License and provided full payment of the license fees for their proposed business located at 14127 Jensen Lane, which is the new Williston Basin Airport terminal location. Per the Williston Code of Ordinances, a notice of this hearing was published and property owners within 150' of the location lot line were notified by certified mail. The application was reviewed by the Liquor & Licensing Committee on July 25, 2019, with a recommendation to approve.

Mayor Klug asked Amy Kruger, Executive Director of the Convention and Visitors Bureau if this license is going to be under Oakwell, how does this affect the application for the gaming license, since it is under a different name. Amy answered the gaming license needs to match whoever is holding the liquor license. The lease would have to be with Oakwells, not with the City of Williston.

- B. Preliminary Plat and Zone Change – Reiger 2<sup>nd</sup> Subdivision

Rachel Laqua from Planning and Zoning presented the following;

This was presented at the July 15, 2019 Planning and Zoning Commission meeting. The plat is for the full twelve acres, the zone change is only for Lot 1, which is a 2.24-acre lot and is the only current accessible lot, as there is no access to Lot 2 via a public road. This is a full

plat because it is previously un-platted property. Lot 2 will remain with A: Agricultural zoning until such point as there is access to Lot 2. In the meantime, a development agreement and deed restriction must be signed noting that Lot 2 may not be developed or rezoned until access to the west is determined. A non-protest agreement must also be signed, waiving the right to protest future improvements to the west or south. A reciprocal access easement will be required to be signed and shown on the plat, benefiting Lot 2 so there is access. There were no public comments. There was a comment from Engineering that if the intention of the owner is to subdivide Lot 1 and sell the tenant spaces as individual units, then they will need separate water and sewer lines. Generally, the City recommends that this be done as it has become more common to split commercial tenant spaces into separate lots. Items required for recordation of this plat include:

1. Final Plat review at Planning and Zoning Commission and City Commission
2. Development Agreement
3. Deed Restriction
4. Easement and Access Agreements
5. Waiver of protest of future improvements to the west and south

The Planning and Zoning Commission recommended approval of this application for the preliminary plat of the Reiger 2nd Subdivision and the zone change from A: Agriculture to C-2: General Commercial for the 2.24-acre Lot 1.

Commissioner Cymbaluk asked if we need to worry about any easement for right of way on the west side of this property. Anthony Dudas Airport Director presented the following;

The City of Williston opened for proposals to provide parking management services at XWA on August 8, 2019. We received two proposals from Republic Parking, which is the current provider at Sloulin Field and Williston Basin Parking. The selected operator was asked to provide information based on four scoring criteria:

1. Relevant business experience
2. Thoroughness of proposal
3. Proposed contractual exceptions
4. Proposed revenue

While both entities provided very thorough proposals, Republic Parking was the highest scoring and provided more relevant business experience. They have managed our current parking with an unorthodox pay before you go method for more than six-years. They have tremendous experience in airport parking around the country and specifically in North Dakota. Additionally, Republic Parking requested fewer exceptions to the proposed contract. Their only exception was based on the percentages of revenue sharing. However, this exception was the most favorable to the City and included a minimum annual revenue guarantee. Lastly, Republic Parking has proposed a more substantial infrastructure investment including covered pay lanes. The RFP review team consisted of Commissioner



Brostuen, City Administrator Tuan, Assistant Airport Director Ryan O'Rear and me. We recommend approval.

Commissioner Bekkedahl asked what type of system they are going to have; will it be the same as what they currently have. Anthony answered it will not be the same, it will be a system where you drive in, get a ticket, park, then when you leave you put the ticket into the machine and pay for the time you were there.

We wanted to meet with them and get their schedule for this project moving forward, as we are getting late into the season. We need assurances from them that they are still on schedule. In addition, we urged the contractor to speak to the school district, in particular, Wilkerson Elementary School and explain to them the schedule and their plan so they can coordinate together.

Mayor Klug asked for the hard start date will be. Dave answered the weekend of August 25-26<sup>th</sup>. Mayor Klug also asked for clarification that two-way traffic will still be maintained and Dave answered yes.

Commissioner Cymbaluk asked if 26<sup>th</sup> Street will be completed and wide open and not be congested. Dave answered the well is coming in on 26<sup>th</sup> Street, which will be here tomorrow and should have 26<sup>th</sup> completed by next week.

Dave answered not at this point, for this project we are just doing the patching and the water main trench. It is on schedule for next year for a mill and overlay of the entire street. It was also clarified the end date is scheduled to for Phase 1 to be this fall, mid-October and Phase II will be next year, early summer to the end of June.

  - 1) XWA Hangar Development Minimum Standards Change

Anthony Dudas Airport Director presented the following;

We received a request to augment our minimum standards for door height and width of a "turboprop" hangar, which are currently 20' high by 80' wide. This request comes from a private hangar tenant and stems from the increased costs to construct a hangar with door height greater than 18 feet and wider than 65 feet. This tenant intends to heat this structure and this increase in height will also have ongoing operational expenses that they feel are not necessary for their intent. The hangar this tenant will be construction is a 100' x 100' with a 65' wide door and an 18' high opening. The turbo-prop aircraft they use are King Air C90, F90, 200 and 350. All of those easily fit within this requested door size change. We recommend approval.

Commissioner Bekkedahl asked if we are changing the minimum standards for "turbo-prop" that we have on record and that we are not just granting a waiver for this request. Anthony answered correct this change will be our new minimum standard.

Commissioner Bekkedahl asked why we had this stricter standard to begin with and was this from a national publication. Anthony answered yes, we utilized a national firm to assist us developing these minimum standards. Anthony also indicated he feels this was not an unreasonable request.

Commissioner Bekkedahl commented he agrees; however, it troubles him that we have brand new standards for a brand-new airport, and we are already changing them. He wanted clarification from Anthony, is there any category of aircraft within turbo-prop, that would not fit into the new standards you are requesting tonight. Anthony answered the only one would be a large commercial turbo-prop aircraft that would not typically be flown by any private entity. It was also clarified that we are only changing the minimums for the turbo-prop and the others will all stay as they are. Anthony also reiterated he did some research on the matter just to be sure there were not any aircraft we may be forgetting.
